INTRODUCTION

Since starting her own practice in 1992, Caroline and her team have creatively shown how the many issues that are fundamental to sustainability can be potent and profound influences as they designed, documented and oversaw the construction of many delightful and restorative places. After 26 years of running her own successful architectural practice, 2018 saw Caroline transition PIDCOCK to a sole person practice, to enable a more agile way of working and focus on how to strategically accelerate action on climate change and the creation of the abundant living future we urgently need.

In addition to her own practice, other roles Caroline currently enjoys include being Co-Chair of the AIA National Climate Action Sustainability Committee; Chair of the AIA Environment Design Guide Advisory Group; member of the Australian Architects Declare steering committee; member of the Northern Beaches Design + Sustainability Advisory Panel and Liverpool Local Planning Panel. She is a sought after speaker, teaching at a range of universities in NSW and a member of Sacred Heart Education Ministry Board (caring for the Sacre Coeur nuns).

Her previous roles as Co-Founder and Spokesperson for Australian Architects Declare a Climate and Biodiversity Emergency; Co-Founder and Chair of the Living Future Institute Australia Board; President of the Australian Sustainable Built Environment Council; President of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects in NSW and National Councillor; Industry Representative on the Australian Building Codes Board; Chair of the 1 Million Women and Carriageworks Boards; Member of Renew Australia (previously ATA) Board, South Australian Forest Industry Advisory Board, NSW Architects Registration Board, Greening Australia NSW Board and Bicycle NSW Board; ambassador for the AI Gore Climate Change project; and adjunct professor/lecturer at a range of universities in NSW, exposed her to many government, business, academic and community arenas.

Caroline has been recognised for her leadership and advocacy in architecture and sustainability with the 2021 EEC Energy Efficiency Champion, 2021 National AIA Leadership in Sustainability Award, the 2019 NSW AIA President's Award, the 2014 International Living Future Institute's Living Building Hero and the 2011 Marian Mahony Griffin Award.
